ROLAND GORE, individual members comprising and constituting the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County, North Carolina, parties of the first part, and hereinafter referred to as "LESSORS", and the Trustees of the Columbus County Hospital, Inc., a public, charitable, non-profit hospital corporation, organized under and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of North Carolina, party of the second part, and hereinafter referred to as "LESSEE":

WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, Lessors have demised and leased, and Lesses accepts as tenant of Lessors, all of that certain tract or parcel of land located in Columbus County and more particularly described as follows:
