The meeting was called to order and The Reverend Bruce Taylor gave the invocation. Rev. Taylor is Pastor of Fair Bluff Methodist Church.

The following business was transacted:

Upon motion made and duly seconded the following orders were unanimously passed:

Ordered: that all Department Heads be notified by the Clerk that they submit an activity report each month either on the first or third Monday.

Ordered: that the 1972 taxes listed in the name of Pargas of Whiteville, Inc., Chadbourn Township, be released in the amount of \$40.80 (Personal Property) due to an error in listing.

A motion was made by Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Brown and unanimously passed to authorize the Clerk to the Board to certify as to the following regarding Lathal R. Wayne, who served as a Fee Deputy for Columbus County from August 8, 1938 through September 1, 1944. Pursuant to his duties of office he rendered an excess of 1,000 hours of service per year. Copies of letters signed by Hugh Nance and Lee J. Greer are to be sent to the Retirement System along with a copy of this motion, supporting the above motion as evidence of his employment.

Mr. Garland Williamson made an offer to the Board to sell 100 acres of property to the County to be used as a landfill site. No decision was made at this time.

A report was given by Mr. Griffin to inform the Board that the roof of the Court house is leaking. The Board instructed Mr. Griffin to find the extent of the damage and get an estimate of the cost to have the necessary repairs made.
