The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Tax Supervisor, Brooks Stanley, gave a report concerning the assessed valuation of the County since the completion of the reappraisal. Upon the basis of the report a motion was made by Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Buffkin, and unanimously carried that the Budget for the FY 1973-74 be prepared on the assessed valuation of \$149,000,000 at a rate of 88% collection of taxes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Currie that a resolution be drawn by the County Attorney and sent to Senator Stallings and others thanking them for their support in their efforts to stop House Bills #724 & 725. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Buffkin and unanimously carried. (see page 700)
