The Meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the Chairman be authorized to sign the forms to the N. C. Board of Health stating that Columbus County is interested in retaining custody of the Packaged Disaster Hospital.

Ordered: that the Statement from McGougan & Wright be paid for services rendered by Mr. McGougan in regards to ^{Senate} ~~House~~ Bill #724 & 725 which ^{would} take authority from County Commissioners.

The Revenue Sharing Budget was discussed briefly and the Auditor was instructed to appropriate \$12,000.00 for Administrative Purposes for 1973-74. To be included in this amount is the salary for a clerk in the Accountant's Office. After this decision was made, the Accountant inquired as to the possibility of retaining Mrs. Blackburn as a permanent employee, as she is now working temporarily.
