The meeting was called to order and the Chairman stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Budget for the FY1974-75.

The Accountant briefed the Board on the request from all departments and a lengthy discussion followed. The Accountant was instructed to contact the Board of Education and ~~ask~~ that they present a more realistic budget request as it is impossible to grant their present application.

A motion was made by Commissioner Williamson that all County employees be granted a 10% increase in salary. There was no second to this motion.

The Clerk was instructed to write the Acme-Delco Fire District for a list of certified names that is to be filed in the office of the Commissioners who are eligible for N. C. Pension Fund coverage and forward the Annual Certification of Firemen to the State Auditor in Raleigh.

Ordered: that Cameron Pridgen be given a check from the ODP Fund for emergency relief.

Ordered that the Chairman be authorized to sign the Annual Certification of Firemen upon the receipt of the list of names from the Acme-Delco Fire District.

A motion was made by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Burns that all County offices be closed on June 4th because of Primary Election Day. Vote was taken as follows: Voting YES Burns and Williamson Voting NO Brown The motion was passed.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned until May 24th, at 8:00 p.m. to further discuss the Budget.
