The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and he stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the distribution of the Emergency Job Program Funds among the Towns and the County. There were representatives from each incorporated town within the County except Fair Bluff. All persons present were allowed to express their views if they so desired. After a lengthy discussion there was general agreement among those present to accept the following distribution of available employees:

Cerro Gordo, Brunswick and Bolton	-	one employee each
Lake Waccamaw and Fair Bluff	-	two employees each
Tabor City and Chadbourne	-	four employees each
Whiteville	-	five employees

These employees are to be paid a minimum wage of \$2.10 per hour, plus fringe benefits. The balance of the funds will be used by the County to hire workers in the various County agencies.

No official action was taken by the Board.
