

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10:00 a.m., July 19, 1982, it being third Monday.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the invocation was given by Reverend John Prince, Jr., Pastor Fellowship Baptist Church.

The minutes of the June 7th, 21st and July 6th were approved as recorded upon motion by Commissioner Hinson and seconded by Commissioner Marlowe.

A motion was made by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Hinson and passed to amend the Recreation Department budget to include equipment for little league in the amount of \$1,200.00 to be appropriated from Surplus.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hinson, seconded by Commissioner Williamson and passed that Dempsey Herring, Recreation Director, be allowed to take his vacation time for a trip to England sponsored by Rotary International. The trip will begin September 1, 1982, and continue for twenty-five working days.

A motion was made by Commissioner Norris, seconded by Commissioner Marlowe and passed that the College be allowed to transfer funds between line items in the 1981-82 budget as filed with the Clerk to the Board. No increase in funds was requested.

A motion was made by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Norris and passed to approve the Surety Bond for Otis Collins in the amount of \$25,000.00.

The following revisions were approved for the Community Development budget subject to the approval of HUD:

Commissioner Norris brought it to the attention of the Board that there are some problems with some of the sites where the green boxes are placed that are used by the Solid Waste Department. He noted one site in the Iron Hill Community which several citizens had complained to him about. A motion was made by Commissioner Hinson that Commissioner Norris find a site for the boxes for a reasonable price and get a permanent site for the location of those boxes.

There was further discussion on the problem of locating the green boxes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marlowe, seconded by Commissioner Williamson and passed that Commissioners Hinson and Norris work out the problem at Iron Hill in locating a permanent site for the green boxes.

There was a discussion concerning the installation of telephones in the remodeled section of the Administrative Building. There was a decision to install three additional telephones, one each in the three offices and none in the conference room. The system is to be the same as now exists on the present telephones in the Finance and Commissioners' offices.

At noon the Board adjourned to the Law Enforcement Center to auction off six cars that had been declared surplus at the Sheriff's Department. The following bids were received on the respective cars:
