Upon motion by Commissioner Dew, seconded by Commissioner Hinson and passed unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 8:50 A.M.


Immediately, a motion was made by Commissioner Dew, seconded by Commissioner Hinson and passed unanimously to reconvene in regular session.


The Administrator reported on a public hearing that was held at the Acme-Delco-Riegelwood Fire Department, June 13, 1984 at 7:30 P.M. concerning a 2½% special service tax increase. There were approximately twenty citizens in attendance who endorsed the increase with no opposition. The public hearing was advertised in the News Reporter and the Wilmington Star News.

Upon motion by Commissioner Hinson, seconded by Commissioner Dew and passed unanimously, the Board adopted the 2½% tax increase for Acme-Delco-Riegelwood Fire Department which totals 7½% for the district.
