APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Byrd, seconded by Commissioner Norris and passed unanimously to approve the January 19, and February 1, 1988 minutes, as recorded.

DOT - REQUEST FOR MIDWAY DEAD-END ROAD BE CLOSED

Mr. Dial Gray addressed the Board requesting that a short dead-end road near the US 74 overpass at the Union Valley Exit be closed. The property on either side is owned by the Bowman heirs (inlaws of Dial Gray).

HEALTH DEPT. - CONTRACT

Todd to provide nursing services at \$9.24 per hour and 22.5¢ per mile for necessary travel. This contract will be retroactive to January 4, 1988 and expire June 30, 1988.


The Board was in agreement with the Administrator.
