Agenda Items #1 and #2: MEETING CALLED to ORDER and INVOCATION:

At 6:30 P.M., Chairman Jacobs called the meeting to order. The invocation was delivered by Commissioner Prevatte. Everyone in attendance stood and pledged Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Agenda Item #3: BOARD MINUTES APPROVAL:

Commissioner McKenzie made a motion to approve the June 16, 2005 Budget Workshop Minutes, as recorded, seconded by Commissioner Norris. The motion so carried.

Agenda Item #4: VETERANS ADMINISTRATION OFFICE LOCATION - DISCUSSION:

Jim Sessions, private citizen and veteran, made the following presentation to the Board for discussion:

1. There are approximately four thousand (4,000) veterans in Columbus County;
2. The veterans spend approximately eighteen (\$18) million dollars in Columbus County annually;
3. I would like for the Board of Commissioners to consider moving the Veterans Administration Office to a more visible location; **and**
4. The present location is a tough place to get to and a tough place to park, and this creates a major hindrance for the elderly and the handicapped.

Commissioner Dutton asked Mr. Sessions if he had any special place in mind for the new location because the Public Utilities Office is outgrowing their space, and needs to be moved to a larger building. Mr. Sessions replied stating no he did not have a special place in mind, but would like the Veterans Administration Office moved to a more visible location with easier access.

Commissioner Memory stated he thought a member of the Columbus County Administration Office, a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Mr. Jim Sessions of American Legion and a member from the local Chapter of Vietnam Veterans of America should get together and locate a suitable location and bring this information back to the Board for further discussion and decision.

Commissioner McKenzie stated he would like to be on this committee.

After additional discussion was conducted relative to a suitable location for the Veterans Administration Office, Commissioner Memory made a motion for a member of the Columbus County Administration Office, a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Mr. Jim Sessions of American Legion, a member from the local Chapter of Vietnam Veterans of America and Commissioner Amon McKenzie to get together and locate a suitable location, and bring this information back to the Board for further discussion and decision. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Norris. The motion so carried.

Agenda Item #5: TIME WARNER FRANCHISE EXTENSION - APPROVAL of REQUEST for FIVE (5) YEAR EXTENSION:

Billy Joe Farmer, County Manager, is requesting approval of the request by Time Warner for a five (5) year extension. Ms. Pat Smith, General Manager of Time Warner stated the following:

1. Time Warner Cable has invested over 3.4 million dollars to provide digital cable services as well as Road Runner High Speed Internet services to our customers in Columbus County.
2. Time Warner Cable provides a choice of over 325 channels to our video subscribers.
3. Time Warner Cable Road Runner High Speed Internet Service is available to residential and business customers.
4. Time Warner Cable has launched Spanish programming for the community.
5. Time Warner Cable has launched HDTV services (High Definition TV).
6. Digital Phone Service is now available in serviceable areas of Columbus County.

Ms. Pat Smith requested approval of the following Resolution for the second (2nd) five (5) year extension of the Franchise Agreement which was approved, adopted and signed at the October 7, 2002 Board of Commissioners Meeting.

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE PERFORMANCE BY TIME WARNER CABLE OF ITS OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE DIGITAL CABLE TELEVISION SERVICE AND HIGH SPEED INTERNET ACCESS AND AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF THE FRANCHISE TERM

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE / INTENT:

The Columbus County Board of Commissioners adopted an Ordinance October 7, 2003 granting a Franchise to Time Warner Cable, which Franchise, in Paragraph IV. A, provided for the establishment of a Franchise term of fifteen (15) years upon Time Warner Cable providing digital cable television service and high speed internet access throughout the service area. It has now been observed that Time Warner Cable has, in fact made provision of those services and The Board of Commissioners hereby finds and acknowledges that the conditions have been met entitling Time Warner Cable to establishment of the fifteen (15) year Franchise term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners that:

1. The Board of Commissioners hereby acknowledge that Time Warner Cable has made provision of digital cable television services and high speed internet access services within the service area; and
2. Based upon the acknowledgment of the provision of services as envisioned in Paragraph IV. A. of the Franchise Ordinance of October 7, 2003, the Franchise term is hereby extended to fifteen (15) years and will now expire on Oct 7, 2018.

Agenda Item #6: JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL - APPROVAL of ANNUAL PLAN:

Melinda H. Lane, Chairperson of the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council, requested Board approval of Columbus County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council's Annual Plan for Fiscal Year 2005-2006. Ms. Lane stated the following:

1. This program has helped reduce and prevent juvenile crime;
2. Our funding for this year has been slightly cut;
3. The money for this program comes from the State;
4. This program has been running for several years; **and**
5. This program has been very successful.

Commissioner Prevatte stated he served on this committee for twenty-five (25) years and was very pleased with the results they have accomplished and this money was being well spent.

Commissioner Prevatte made a motion to approve the Columbus County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council's Annual Plan for Fiscal Year 2005-2006, seconded by Vice Chairman Godwin. The motion so carried. **Due to the size of this document, a copy of this plan will be kept on file in the Office of the Clerk to the Board for review.**

Agenda Item #7: SOCIAL SERVICES - DEPARTMENTAL UPDATE:

Mary Thompson, Social Worker Program Manager and Assistant Director, presented the following Social Services Departmental Update:

1. We operate on a budget of \$13,423,173.00;
2. We have 132 employees;
3. 8,284 Food Stamp participants served with 3,466 cases at \$704,885.00 monthly;
4. Children's Medicaid - 7,727 children served in various categories;
5. Adult Medicaid - 5,892 adults served in various programs;
6. Work First Cash Assistance - 573 cases monthly serving 1,401 individuals:
 - A. Employment - 225 participants monthly;
 - B. 92 gained employment;
 - C. 10 Received funds through the domestic violence allocation;
7. Day Care - 1,365 children received services through the state subsidy and Smart Start allocations;
8. Program Integrity - collected \$109,567.45;
9. Heating/Cooling Programs - 8,569 households served;
10. Services Unit - 491 child protective services investigations (970 children);
11. 258 Victim children received services after the initial investigation;
12. We have 18 licensed foster homes;
13. We average 50 children monthly in DSS custody who are in placements outside parents home;
14. Finalized 14 adoptions;
15. Adult Services - investigated 166 protective services referrals;
16. We are guardians of 10 adults;
17. 2540 Medicaid Transportation clients served monthly; **and**
18. Child Support Unit collected \$4,453,299.00.

Commissioner McKenzie stated that he and the entire Board appreciated all the hard work the staff at Social Services performs.

WHEREAS, on December 26, 1928, in the Town of Fair Bluff, Columbus County, North Carolina, Mr. and Mrs. Henry P. Evans was blessed with a child, namely **Joe Barden Evans**; **and**

WHEREAS, the above stated citizen completed his elementary education at Carver Elementary School, his high school education at Westside High School, and continued on with his education at Fayetteville Technical Institute in Fayetteville, North Carolina; **and**

WHEREAS, **Joe Barden Evans**, referred to as **J.B. Evans**, served his country in the United States Army from 1950-1956 and received the Good Conduct Medal, the Occupational Medal and an Honorable Discharge; **and**

WHEREAS, after discharge from his military service, **Mr. Evans** was gainfully employed by Mayfield Looseleaf Floors Warehouse as Supervisor of Labor and Shipping/Receiving for thirty (30) years and retired on December 17, 1993; **and**

WHEREAS, in 1969, this said gentleman was the first African American to be elected in Columbus County by the Town of Fair Bluff and served for twenty-four (24) years as Town Commissioner, inclusive of twenty-two (22) years as Mayor Pro Tem; **and**

WHEREAS, The Honorable Joe Barden Evans' illustrious career as a public servant resulted in his election as Mayor of the Town of Fair Bluff in 1993 with continuous service at the present; **and**

WHEREAS, the Boards and/or committees the named public servant presently serves on are as follows:
