PUBLIC HEARING: **Proposed 2007 - 2008 Community Transportation Program:** to receive written and/or oral comments from the Public.

PUBLIC HEARING CALLED to ORDER:

At 6:30 P.M., Chairman Godwin called the Public Hearing to order, and stated the purpose was to receive written and/or oral comments from the public on the Proposed 2007 -2008 Community Transportation Program. Chairman Godwin requested that Charles Patton, Transportation Director, present an overview of this program. Mr. Patton stated the following:

1. The Community Transportation Program provides assistance to coordinate existing transportation programs operating in Columbus County;
2. Provides transportation options and services for the communities within this service area;
3. Services are currently provided using Demand Response and Subscription Routes;
4. Services are rendered by using vans through Columbus County Transportation;
5. The total amount of this grant is three hundred seventy thousand, five hundred and 00/100 (\$370,500.00) dollars, with a local share of forty-three thousand, three hundred twenty-five, and 00/100 (\$43,325.00) dollars; **and**
6. The required local share will be taken from the transportation reserve.

Chairman Godwin opened the floor for public comments. No public comments, either oral or written, were received.

PUBLIC HEARING CLOSED:

At 6:40 P.M., Commissioner McKenzie made a motion to close the Public Hearing, seconded by Commissioner Jacobs. The motion unanimously carried.

At 6:40 P.M., Chairman Godwin called the meeting to order. The invocation was delivered by Commissioner Amon E. McKenzie. Everyone in attendance stood and pledged Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, which was led by Commissioner Sammie Jacobs.

Agenda Item #4: DREAM CENTER - UPDATE of ACTIVITIES and REQUEST APPROVAL to APPLY for a CAPACITY BUILDING GRANT:

Ms. Evelyn A. Troy, DREAM Center Director, presented the following update to the Board on their activities, and requested approval to apply for a Capacity Building Grant from the Division of Community Assistance.

1. I would like to introduce the following people that are here with me tonight, as follows: Robert Little, President, Wanda Davis, Secretary, Zilphia Collier, Assistant Secretary, Arcelia Wicker, Consultant for Affordable Housing out of Charlotte, Asia Coleman, Housing Development Manager, and Harold Troy, Volunteer for Outreach Consultant, that works with victims of prostate cancer;
2. I would like to thank the Board of Commissioners for their support and the plaque that we received;
3. In 1991, we started out as the Alcohol and Drug Prevention Coalition;
4. In 1997, we changed our name to the DREAM Center, and DREAM is an acronym that stands for Development Resource and Early Prevention Awareness Motivation;
5. Currently the DREAM Center is implementing seven (7) funded programs and several unfunded programs;
6. Throughout the County, we serve many clients countywide;
7. I would like to address our Housing Program, and following are some of the things that we have done with this program:
 - between 2000-2003, the DREAM Center identified 627 families, in our County, that met the guidelines for Hurricane Floyd funds, and identified several others that did not meet the guidelines
 - in 2002, we conducted a countywide survey, and it highlighted the needs for affordable workforce housing
 - we have conducted several annual housing fairs
 - in 2003, we have conducted home buyers extension classes, and have seven (7) that have successfully completed that program, and are now becoming accredited to purchase
 - the next logical step is construction
8. There are funds available for the construction of housing, but the DREAM Center has to have experience in construction to access those funds, and that is where we are;
9. We are not asking the County for money, we are asking the County to be the conduit, or the median, for the Dream Center to receive money to gain that experience, the training, to build the capacity for construction, and that is where we come into the Capacity Building Grant Program, which is operated through the Division of Community Assistance;
10. The proposed strategy is to collaborate with the following partners for success in building a scattered site project of six (6) affordable, workforce houses in Columbus County:
 - The Affordable Housing Group, Charlotte;
 - Metropolitan CDC, Washington, NC; **and**
 - JFK Consultants, Winston Salem.
11. DREAM Center will gain capacity for development and construction;
12. Families will be equipped with training on how to avoid foreclosure and predatory lending;
13. Some of the requirements for the Capacity Building Grant include the following:
 - Application must be from a county or town for a non-profit organization;
 - Public hearing must be conducted;
 - Intent to submit a CDBG within twenty-four (24) months after the close of the Capacity Building Grant; **and**
 - Prospective applicants must meet with DCA prior to making application;
14. This will be a grant for seventy-five thousand, and 00/100 (\$75,000.00) dollars that will be used for the purposes of educating our clients and providing the DREAM Center with the construction experience they need to apply for the CDBG Grant; **and**

15. There is a maximum threshold for Columbus County of \$1,250,000.00 for CDBG grants, and this will not affect this threshold.

After extensive and in-depth discussion between the Board members, Ms. Evelyn Troy and Arcelia Wicker, discovery was established that the seventy-five thousand and 00/100 (\$75,000.00) dollars grant would be utilized for the training opportunities for staff, and funds to get assistance from Metropolitan, CDC, in Washington, North Carolina. Once the training has been completed, and the construction experience has been acquired, then the DREAM Center would apply for the Scattered Site Funds.

Commissioner McKenzie made a motion to approve Ms. Evelyn Troy, Director of The DREAM Center, Incorporated, to apply for a Capacity Building Grant from the Division of Community Assistance. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Memory and so carried.

Agenda Item #5: WATER FLUORIDATION - RESOLUTION of SUPPORT for WATER FLUORIDATION:

Dr. Randolph Matthews requested Board approval and adoption of the following Resolution of Support for Water Fluoridation.

Agenda Item #6: COLUMBUS COUNTY BOARD of EDUCATION - DECLINATION of SURPLUS PROPERTY:

William W. Phipps, Attorney for the Columbus County Board of Education, has requested the Columbus County Board of Commissioners to decline to accept a fifty-two feet by fifty-two feet (52' x 52') tract of property lying on the Northeast edge of the Cerro Gordo Elementary School. This request is pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 115C-518. Mr. Phipps has informed the Board if they should decline to accept this property, the Columbus County Board of Education could convey it the Town of Boardman for the purposes of establishing a sewer lift station.

Chairman Godwin stated the following relative to this matter:

1. This property is needed for a sewer lift station by the Town of Boardman;
2. William W. Phipps, Attorney for the Columbus County Board of Education, is asking the Board to decline to accept this property, which will allow them to convey the same to the Town of Boardman;
3. The proposed sewer system will include the Town of Boardman, the Town of Fair Bluff and the Town of Cerro Gordo; **and**
4. The attorney is aware of the error listing the Town of Cerro Gordo in lieu of the Town of Boardman in his letter.

Commissioner Prevatte stated the following relative to this matter:

- 1. It is my understanding that this is a trade off with West Columbus High School and Cerro Gordo Elementary School; **and**
- 2. This is basically a gentlemen’s agreement.

Commissioner Jacobs made a motion to decline to accept the property, as described in the first paragraph of this Agenda item, that has been declared surplus by the Columbus County Board of Education. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Memory and unanimously carried.

Charles Patton, Public Transportation Director, requested approval and authorization for the Chairman to sign the following Resolution, and all related documents, for the FY 2007 - 2008 Community Transportation Program.

Enter Into Agreement with The North Carolina Department Of Transportation
And to Provide the Necessary Assurances.

A motion was made by Commissioner McKenzie and seconded by Commissioner Memory for the adoption of the following resolution, and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted.

WHEREAS, Article 2B of Chapter 136 of the North Carolina General Statutes and the Governor of North Carolina have designated the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) as the agency responsible for administering federal and state public transportation funds; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation will apply for a grant from the US Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration and receives funds from the North Carolina General Assembly to provide assistance for rural public transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of these transportation funds is to provide grant monies to local agencies for the provision of rural public transportation services consistent with the policy requirements for planning, community and agency involvement, service design, service alternatives, training and conference participation, reporting and other requirements (drug and alcohol testing policy and program, disadvantaged business enterprise program, and fully allocated costs analysis);

WHEREAS, COLUMBUS COUNTY hereby assures and certifies that it will comply with the federal and state Statutes, regulations, executive orders, Section 5333 (b) Warranty, and all administrative requirements which relates to the applications made to and grants received from the Federal Transit Administration, as well as the provisions of Section 1001 of Title 18, U. S. C.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the *Chairman, of the Columbus County Commissioners is hereby authorized to submit a grant application for federal and state funding, make the necessary assurances and certifications and be empowered to enter into an agreement with the NCDOT to provide rural public transportation services.

NaTonya Hassell, Executive Director, requested Board approval and adoption of the following Resolution Adopting the Payment Standards for Columbus County Public Housing Authority.

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PAYMENT STANDARDS FOR COLUMBUS COUNTY
PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY**

Resolution: 2006-01

WHEREAS, the Columbus County Public Housing Authority of Columbus County, North Carolina, may annually adjust the Payment Standard used in the Housing Choice Voucher Program to levels that are appropriate to assist lower income families in finding affordable rental units in our jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the Quality Housing and Work Responsibility Act of 1998 gave housing agencies the authority to set payment standards within a range of 90% to 110% of the HUD established Fair Market Rents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Payment Standards for Housing Choice Vouchers used in Columbus County Public Housing Agency, Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program be set at 110% of the FMRs as follows: 0 - bedroom: \$399; 1 - bedroom: \$515; 2 - bedroom: \$571; 3- bedroom: \$684; 4 - bedroom: \$704; 5 - bedroom: \$810; 6 - bedroom: \$915.

Agenda Item #9: HEALTH - APPROVAL of PURCHASE of NEW SOFTWARE for ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH:

Kim Smith, Health Director, requested approval of the purchase of new software for Environment Health. Ms. Smith stated the following:

1. The computer system for Environmental Health crashed in the middle of August, 2006;
2. We have looked at three (3) different systems, and this system meets the requirements of what we need;
3. This system also includes programs that we will need for future requirements;
4. The cost of the system is fourteen thousand, one hundred, and 00/100 (\$14,100.00) dollars, with an annual service agreement of four thousand, two hundred, and 00/100 (\$4,200.00) dollars, for seven (7) users;
5. This system does include a backup system; **and**
6. We do have the money in our budget.

Commissioner Jacobs made a motion to approve the purchase of new software for

Environmental Health, at the cost of fourteen thousand, one hundred, and 00/100 (\$14,100.00) dollars, with an annual service agreement at the cost of four thousand, two hundred, and 00/100 (\$4,200.00) dollars, and the approval of a budget amendment for this amount, to move this amount to the Environmental Health Budget. This motion was seconded by Commissioner McKenzie and unanimously carried.

Agenda Item #10: COOPERATIVE EXTENSION - APPROVAL of NEW MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING:

Jackie Roseboro, Cooperative Extension Director, requested Board approval of a new Memorandum of Understanding Between The Board of County Commissioners and The North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service, North Carolina State University, and The North Carolina Cooperative Extension Program, North Carolina A&T State University.

Chairman Godwin stated the following:

1. This is a new Memorandum of Understanding that Ms. Roseboro is requesting Board approval for;
2. Ms. Roseboro served on the committee that prepared this document;
3. The lock-in provision has been eliminated; **and**
4. The last Memorandum of Understanding was signed on May 19, 1993.

Ms. Roseboro stated that the main difference is the committee merged a Memorandum of Understanding and a Memorandum of Agreement together.

Commissioner Prevatte made a motion to approve the new Memorandum of Understanding Between The Board of County Commissioners and The North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service, North Carolina State University, and The North Carolina Cooperative Extension Program, North Carolina A&T State University, seconded by Commissioner Memory. Agenda Item #11: SOIL and WATER CONSERVATION - DEPARTMENTAL UPDATE:

Edward Davis, Soil and Water Conservation Director, delivered the following Departmental Update:

1. Conservation districts consist of federal, state and local agencies;
2. Natural Resources Conservation Service is a USDA Agency, and provides landowners with federal conservation programs;
3. NRCS provides districts with engineering field manuals consisting of 18 chapters of information for engineering purposes from hydraulics to water management;
4. The Electronic Field Office Tech Guide (eFOTOG) is broken into 8 sections;
5. The Division of Soil and Water is a part of DEHNR, directed by the 7 member Soil and Water Commission; Commission members are appointed by the Governor; and the division, through the Commission, administrates State programs awarded to the districts;
6. Columbus Soil and Water's district staff is as follows:
 - Donna G. Register, District Conservationist
 - Amanda F. Wright, Administrative Assistant
 - Greg W. Davis. Water Quality Technician
 - Edward E. Davis. Engineering Technician;
7. Districts are directed by a Board of 5 Supervisors, 3 elected and 2 appointed; **and**
8. The best management practices are:
 - Animal Mortality Disposal System;
 - Livestock Watering Tanks;
 - Clean Water Makes Happy Cows;
 - Livestock Exclusion, Stream Crossing and Stock Trail
 - Animal Waste Management;
 - Animal Waste Utilization;
 - Cropland Conversion to Grass;
 - Cropland Conversion to Trees;
 - Shallow Water Impoundment;
 - No-Till Drill For Rent;

- Wildlife Enhancement;
- Erosion Control;
- Drainage Problems Throughout the County;
- Beaver Management; **and**
- Education.
